### **Resolution Health Medical Scheme slams rumours**

Johannesburg – Resolution Health Medical Scheme (RHMS) has slammed comments made on Radio Kragbron by a broker Gideon Lambrecht of PFS Wealth Management that the Scheme will be closing at the end of November 2009.

“This kind of misinformation is very harmful to the Scheme and its members and is in fact totally unfounded”, said Mrs Helene van der Walt, Acting Principal Officer of RHMS.

The Administrator for RHMS has been in a dispute with the Council for medical Schemes regarding a number of technical matters related to administration and it is this ongoing court battle which has caused many opportunistic competitors to attempt to capitalise on the situation.

Resolution Health Medical Scheme and the Administrator, Resolution Health, are separate entities and the disputes with the Council do not affect the Scheme, its ability to cover its members or their benefits.

“It is business as usual. Current processes regarding the administrator, are taking place seamlessly and members will not be affected in anyway regardless of the outcome., van der Walt assured.

“Members of RHMS have nothing to fear, the Scheme is financially sound and remains amongst the best options in the market”, van der Walt added.
